TERMS OF SERVICE AND COPYRIGHT POLICY

HOW 3D-READY COLLECTS INFORMATION

User Provided Information: You provide certain personally identifiable information (such as your name and email address) to 3D-Ready when choosing to participate in various activities on the 3D-Ready Site such as uploading content, posting content or subscribing to newsletters or other mailing lists.

Cookies Information: When you visit the 3D-Ready Site, we may send one or more cookies - a small text file containing a string of alphanumeric characters - to your computer that uniquely identifies your browser. 3D-Ready uses both session cookies and persistent cookies. A persistent cookie remains after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the site. - Protecting, investigating and deterring against fraudulent, harmful, unauthorized or illegal activity

We process Personal Data for purposes such as:

- To process your orders and deliver the Products that you have ordered.
- To provide reports based on information collected from use of our Products.
- To keep you up to date on the latest Product announcements, software updates, software upgrades, system enhancements, special offers, and other information
- To provide support and assistance for our Products
- To provide the ability to create personal profile areas and view protected content.
- To provide the ability to contact you and provide you with shipping and billing information.
- To provide customer feedback and support
- To the extent you choose to participate, to conduct questionnaires and surveys in order to provide better products and services to our customers and end users.
- To support recruitment inquiries
- To personalize marketing communications and website content based on your preferences, such as in response to your request for specific information on products and services that may be of interest.
- To contact individuals that you refer to us and identify you as the source of the referral, in accordance with the “Referral” section below.
- To meet contract or legal obligations

Referrals

3D-READY PLATFORM PRIVACY POLICY

3D-Ready and its subsidiaries (collectively, “3D-Ready,” “we” or “us”) understand the importance of privacy. This Platform Privacy Policy (this “Policy”) explains how 3D-Ready collects, stores, uses and shares personal information collected, stored or processed by us through 3D-Ready’s Virtual Platform, which includes services related to our Virtual Events/Congresses and Virtual Environments, (collectively, the “Platform”). In this Policy, “personal information” is information that identifies or could be used to identify an individual.

The 3D-Ready Platform is a tool used by businesses (including direct customers of 3D-Ready and customers who access the Platform through an 3D-Ready customer) and their employees, agents and authorized users (the “Business Customers”) to deliver events in virtual reality and other content to registrants, attendees, participants, and other end users (the “End Users”). Collectively, End Users and Business Customers are “Platform Users”.

1. SCOPE

This Policy applies to the personal information that 3D-Ready’s Business Customers submit to us via the Platform, as well as the personal information we collect, access, store, use or otherwise process (collectively, “process”) via the Platform on behalf of Business Customers, including the Registrant Information, Other Information and User Communications (each defined below), as well as other personal information we process from End Users of the Platform (together the “Platform Data”).

GDPR and EU Data Protection Law

3D-Ready is a data processor for the Platform Data, under EU data protection laws (including those implementing the EU General Data Protection Regulation, or “GDPR”). As a data processor, we will only process the Platform Data pursuant to our client’s instructions, as set forth in our applicable client agreements, and as otherwise required by applicable EU data protection laws. 2. DATA COLLECTED

Information Collected Directly

Account Information. To access various parts of the Platform, and to create webinars and events, you must have an online account. To register for an account on the Platform, you must provide your name, email address, telephone number, company name, and other information necessary to confirm that you are an authorized user of a Business Customer (where relevant). We may also collect additional information such as job title, information about your company (such as country and industry sector) and other user profile information such as age, gender, zip code, and areas of special interest to you. Our processing of account information is subject to the 3D-Ready Online Privacy Policy.

End User Information. To access webinars, virtual environments and other events administered by Business Customers via the Platform as an End User, you may be required to register. While our Business Customers determine what information to collect from End Users, the requested personal information typically includes name, email address, telephone number, company name and job title as well as information about your company such as country and industry sector.

User Communications. When you send email or other communication to 3D-Ready or another user, we may retain those communications in order to process your enquiries, respond to your requests and to improve our services.

Affiliated Sites. We may offer services in connection with other websites or suppliers. Personal information that you provide to those sites may be sent to us in order to deliver these services. We process such information in accordance with this Policy.

Other Information. 3D-Ready's Business Customers may request additional information, like surveys or polls, be filled out in some webinars or virtual environments. Business Customers are responsible for configuring the Platform to collect such personal information.

Information Collected Automatically

Log Information. When you use 3D-Ready, our servers record, in a server log, information that your browser sends whenever you visit a website. Server logs may include information such as your web request, Internet Protocol address, browser type, browser language, the date and time of your request and one or more cookies that may uniquely identify your browser.

Cookies, clear GIFs, etc. The Platform may use cookies (small pieces of information that are stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive), clear GIFs, java script and other technology to collect and store information about your use of the Platform, such as your search activity, the pages you view, and the date and time of your visit, your browser type, type of computer or mobile device, browser language, IP address, mobile carrier, unique device identifier, location information, and requested and referring URLs. 3. We may disclose the information we collect from you to 3D-Ready affiliates and subsidiaries; however, if we do so, their use and disclosure of your information will be subject to this Policy.

Third parties who process personal information on our behalf must agree to use such personal information only for the purpose for which it is provided by us and they must contractually agree to provide adequate protections for personal information; 3D-Ready will continue to be liable for any onward transfers of personal information to such third parties.

We may also disclose personal information in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements, as well as where is necessary to satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable government request, to enforce our User Agreement and investigate violations thereof, to prevent, detect and address fraud, security or technical issues, or to protect against harm to the rights and property of 3D-Ready.

If we are acquired by or merged with another company, if substantially all of our assets are transferred to another company (including as due diligence and for other purposes prior to the closing of such a transaction), or as part of a bankruptcy proceeding, we may transfer the information we have collected (including personal information) to the acquiring company.

5. ACCESSING, AMENDING AND LIMITING USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Individuals have the right to access the personal information that is maintained about them, and in some cases to limit use and disclosure of such information. Registered Platform Users may log into their accounts to view and amend certain personal information in their profile.
